GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

These rules should be observed at all times

- All students are required to remain in the compound during the short break times and between classes.
- If classes are missed, a written note should be sent by a Parent/Guardian.
- Do not bring electronic games, playing cards etc.
- Under no condition will rudeness or disruptive behavior be tolerated in or out of class. **Cell phones must be switched off during classes. Do not use electrical outlets. No playing of music at any time on the school compound. No photos, video or voice recording anywhere on the school compound.**

- Do not invite or encourage “friends” or other persons to meet or visit you inside or outside, before, during or after classes.
- Students caught defacing or damaging school property will be required to pay for the damages.
- No chewing of gum, no wearing of hats / caps. Regular jackets are allowed.. No hoodies. No correction fluid, dividers, compasses, sharp objects of any kind (including knives).

- ALL** Students are expected to dress **sensibly** and **appropriately** for the school environment.

NO: Shorts, sleeveless vests, ripped jeans.

FOR GIRLS ADDITIONALLY:

NO: leggings, tights, short/tight skirts, crop tops, sleeveless tops, transparent clothing.

- School authorities will not be held responsible for money and / or other valuables lost within the compound.
- Do not touch or adjust lights, fans or air conditioning controls.
- All students should conduct themselves with appropriate decorum. Avoid loud, boisterous behavior etc. No pairing off or “romancing”.
- Any student who is rude, disrespectful or aggressive in any manner to teachers, security officers, café workers, janitorial staff or students will be withdrawn from classes.**
- Students should always keep emergency sanitary supplies.
- There are no classes on Saturday 2nd November.
